#### **Entering Student Survey 2008 Background**

During Summer New Student Orientation 2008, Student Affairs piloted an Entering Student Survey to gather information about incoming freshmen. The survey asked students about their behaviors, attitudes and expectations. About 20 minutes was allocated during the Orientation program for students to complete the survey. The survey administration was approved though UIC IRB protocol #2008-0384.

The Entering Student Survey was designed by campus administrators as a paper and pencil instrument – 2 pages on a single sheet of paper. Many of the questions cover areas that are similar to those addressed by national entering student surveys. Past experience with low completion rates using the national surveys suggested a need keep the survey brief and avoid questions that did not have a practical use or application for the campus. By requesting that students provide their University Identification Number (UIN), we also eliminated the need to collect demographic information which could be extracted from the student record.

A total of 2025 surveys were returned (approximately 68% of entering freshman class of 2964). 377 students did not provide or provided incomplete UIN information, thus 1648 students shared useable UIN numbers. The distribution of survey participants compared to the New Freshman Class is shown in the tables below:
