1,337 students finished the Spring 2019 term without earning a degree (in Spring or Summer) and didn't return for Fall 2019. Of that group, 209 finished Spring on Drop status and are therefore assumed not have been eligible to register.

Across all colleges, 405 eligible non-returners finished Spring 2019 on academic probation (average GPA 1.13, StdDev 0.756). For sake of comparison, a total of 1,970 undergraduate students finished Spring 2019 on probation with an average GPA of 2.03.

Another 723 eligible non-returners finished in good standing (average GPA 3.01, StdDev 0.649). Across all undergraduates, 16,170 finished Spring 2019 in good standing with an average GPA of 3.18.
