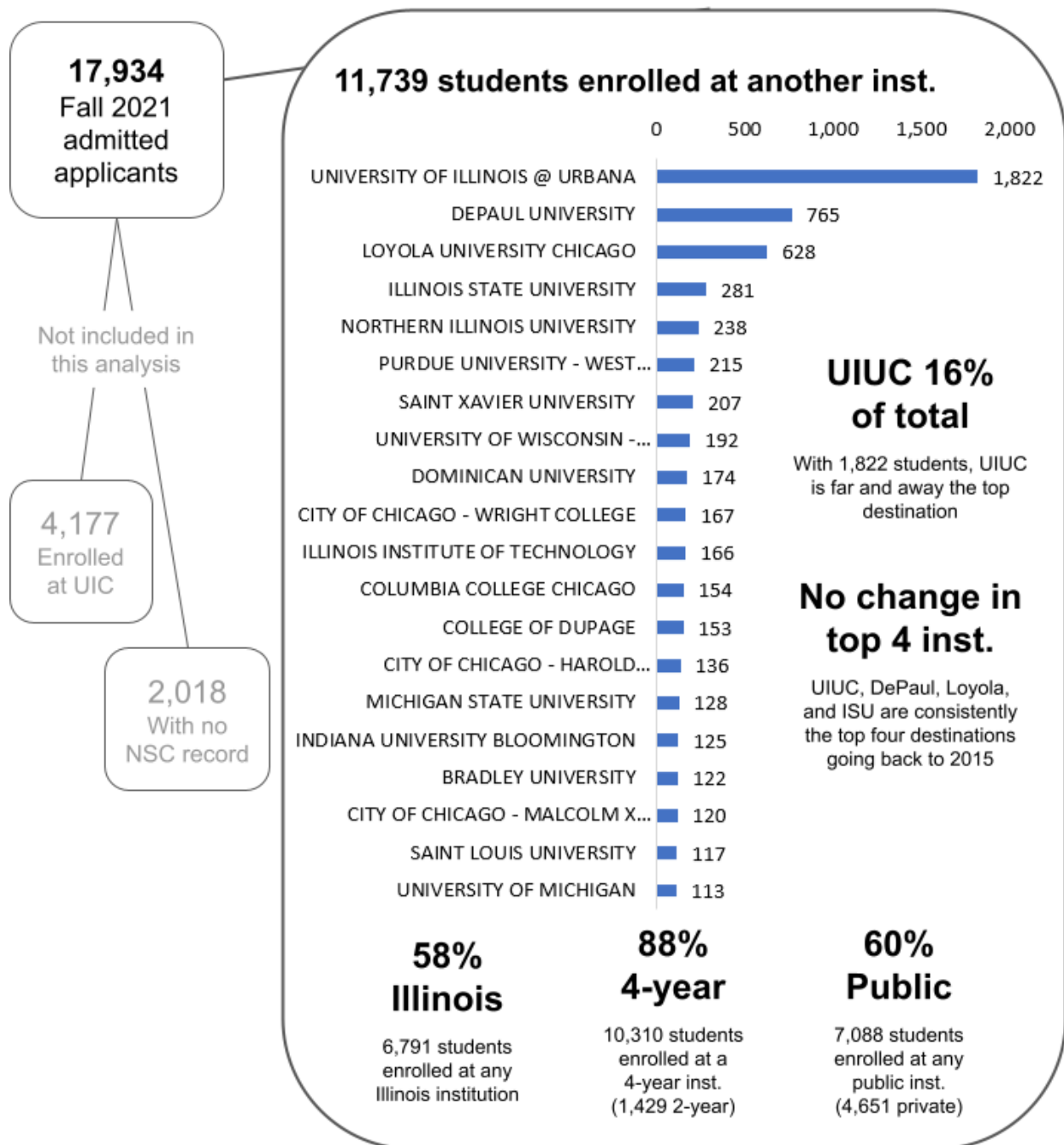

# Fall 2021 Admitted, Not Enrolled at a glance

## If not UIC, then where?

Prospective college students have options in where to enroll, and each year, a majority of prospective first-year students offered admission by UIC choose to enroll at another institution. AES tracks the subsequent enrollment institution of these students from the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) to gauge our primary yield competitors and better understand the types of institutions that draw students who don't choose UIC.



# Summary & Methods

Prospective first-year students submitted 23,542 applications for admission to UIC in the Fall 2021 term. A total of 18,093 offers of admission across eight colleges went out to 17,934 individual applicants. UIC enrolled 4,177 new first-year students in Fall 2021, for a yield rate of 23%. The 13,737 students who were admitted but did not enroll at UIC were submitted to the National Student Clearinghouse. 11,739 returned an enrollment record at one of the 3,600 U.S. institutions participating in NSC.

This report seeks to answer the question, “If not UIC, then where?” Analysis of the NSC subsequent enrollment data helps to define UIC’s market competition in enrolling new first-year students. This is mostly completed using 3 tables:

- Overall numbers by institution type and control, which help show differences in tendencies towards public/private or 2-year/4-year institutions.
- Top destinations, i.e. the institutions enrolling the most students, which show some measure of relative strength between subsequent institutions.
- Heat maps, highlighting the percent of each column enrolling at a particular institution, which show at a quick glance differences in destinations by college and race/ethnicity.

First, the following three tables provide 1) counts of applications, admits, and enrolls by college, 2) counts of applicants, admits, and enrolls by IPEDS race/ethnicity, and 3) a crosstab of admits by college and IPEDS race/ethnicity. Note that an individual applicant can submit multiple applications to different colleges. The first two tables include the admit rate, the percentage of admitted apps, and the yield rate, the percentage of enrolled admits.

## Results

A total of 11,739 enrollment records were returned from the NSC. Overall, the 87.8% proportion of students enrolling at a 4-year university represents a return to levels seen from 2015 to 2018 after 2019 (86%) and 2020 (85%) saw slightly lower rates of 4-year enrollment. The Private/Public breakdown has not changed a lot over the years, though 2020 and 2021 saw slightly higher rates of Public enrollment at 60% than previous years (58% Public 2015-18).

Of the 11,739 students with enrollment records, 6,791 enrolled at an institution in Illinois (57.8%). That percentage saw a slight increase to 62% for the first pandemic cohort in 2020; more than returning to pre-pandemic levels (around 59-60%), though, this rate is the lowest rate of students staying in Illinois in recent years.

## Rank order of top 10 since 2015

The top four institutions of UIUC, DePaul, Loyola, and ISU remain unchanged from 2020 and 2019. NIU moved up five spots from 10th in 2020 to 5th in 2021, as did Dominican University from 14th last year to 9th this year. Wright College and IIT, on the other hand, each dropped five spots from last year; IIT finished outside the top 10 for the first time since 2015.

## Top 20 institutions in 2021 compared to 2020

UIUC had a 6.6% increase from 2020 with 1,822 enrolled students. The highest percent increases in the top 20 were NIU (up 36.8%), Michigan State (up 37.6%), and the University of Michigan (up 59.2% after a down year in 2020). While not cracking the top 20, the University of Minnesota ranked 22nd with 110 enrolled students, up 71.9% from last year and nearly equaling its 116 combined total from 2019 and 2020. IIT and Bradley are both down from each of the past two years. Among a few 2-year institutions down, Moraine Valley ranked 25th with 96 students after averaging 120 students per year in 2019 and 2020.

# By Race/Ethnicity

## Asian student destinations

In Fall 2021, Asian students were the most likely to enroll at a 4-year university and the most likely to enroll at a public institution out of the six race/ethnicity groups included in the analysis. Two out-of-state institutions - Purdue and Wisconsin - cracked the top 5 destinations. A top destination overall, ISU (not pictured) ranked tied for 26th with 17 Asian students enrolled.

## Black student destinations

Like Asian students, more than 90% of Black admits enrolled at a 4-year institution. They were similarly more likely than other categories analyzed to enroll at public institutions. Two HBCUs - Howard and Xavier - ranked in the top 15 destinations, while a total of 182 (12.6%) Black students enrolled at an HBCU, including 39 among the Atlanta University Center of Morehouse (15 students), Spelman (13), and Clark(11).

## Latinx student destinations

Latinx students had one of the highest rates of 2-year attendance at 18.7%, while having the highest rates of private institution attendance at 44.4% for those attending a 4-year. Top overall institutions like NIU and ISU were least likely destinations than Saint Xavier and Dominican at the 4-year level and three CCC campuses (Wright, Harold Washington, Malcolm X) at the 2-year level.

## White student destinations

White students in Fall 2021 saw higher rates of public and 4-year enrollment when compared to Latinx, AI/AN, and ME/NA students, but neither of those rates were as high as Asian or Black students. For Asian, Black, and Latinx students, UIUC enrolls at least two-times as many students as the second most-popular destination; there is a more even distribution across UIUC, DePaul, and Loyola in this group.

## Non-IPEDS - AI/AN student destinations

The AI/AN category in this analysis represents any student who identifies as American Indian or Alaska Native, regardless of IPEDS category. This population enrolled at 2-year institutions at a higher rate (21.2%) than another group and had 4 CCC campuses (Harold Washington, Malcolm X, Wright, and Daley) ranked in the top 15 destinations.

## Non-IPEDS - ME/NA student destinations

The ME/NA category in this report is represented by students who identified as White-then-Middle-East in race/ethnicity questions or who has citizenship in a Middle East or North African country, regardless of IPEDS category. While the majority of these students would typically be reported as White, their rates differ from the overall White IPEDS group with higher rates of 2-year attendance (14.4%) and higher rates of private institution attendance (42.5%).

## By Geography

### Cook County permanent address student destinations

When looking at geography, [CPS graduates](#) (17.8%) and Cook County residents in general (15.8%) saw higher rates of 2-year attendance than residents of the collar counties, other states, and other countries. UIUC accounted for 18.8% of the subsequent enrollments from Cook county residents. While not included in the tables, 4,473 (76.8%) of the Cook County residents attended an Illinois institution.

## Collar counties permanent address student destinations

More than half (51.4%) of collar county residents attended a public, 4-year institution, compared to 37.5% of Cook County residents. Collar county residents were less likely to attend an Illinois institution 1,631 students staying in Illinois (63.7%).

## Domestic, out-of-state permanent address destinations

US residents from outside of Illinois were more likely to choose DePaul or Loyola than UIUC if they attended an Illinois institution, but only 235 (9.4%) of the ANE group enrolled in Illinois. Around two-thirds of the group enrolled at a public, 4-year institution.
